In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Thmil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Ceneral Rules (Part II of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules) in Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1977.

2. The amendment hereby made shill come into force on and from the 7th October 1936.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 22, after clause (4), the following clause shall be inserted, namely: -

- "(aa) Out of the total number of appointments reserved in the categories referred to in clause (a), three percent in each such category shall be reserved. for the physically handicapped candidates and the appointment shall be made in turn and in the order of rotation as specified below: -
- (i) in the case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribos, every second turn shill be reserved in the second, sixth and tenth rotations and thereafter in the fourteenth, sighteenth, twenty second rotations and so on;
 - (ii) in the case of Backward Classes, every thirty fourth turn shall be reserved in the second, third and fourth rotations and thereafter in the sixth, seventh, eighth rotations and so on;

(iii) in the case of appointment of candidates on the basis of merit, every eighteenth turn shall be reserved in the second, fourth and sixth rotations and thereafter in the eighth, tenth, twelfth rotations and so on;

Provided that the appointment of physically hand capped ca-ndidates, against the reserved turns shall be subject to a vailability of such candidates:

Provided further that if no qualified and suitable physically handicapped candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe is available for selection for appointment against the reserved turn, such turn shall be filled up by a candidate other than physically handicapped belonging to that category a nd if no such candidate is available in that category for selection for appointment against the reserved turn; such turn shall be carried forward to the next recruitment, as provided in claims (d). in clause (d):

belonging to Backward Classes or in the case of appointment of candidates candidates on the basis of morit, if no qualification and subtable physically handicapped candidate is available for selection for appointment against the reserved turn, such turn shall be filled up by a candidate other than physically handicapped belonging to up by a candidate other than physically handicapped belonging to that category and if no such candidate is available in that category for selection for appointment against the reserved turn, such turn shall be allowed to lapse".
