G.O. Ms. No. 602, Social Welfare, 14th August 1981.

Social Welfare—Rehabilitation of Physically Handicapped-International year of Disabled persons-1981-Reservation of appointments in Public Services and reservation of seats in Educational Institutions for Physically Handicapped persons-Percentage of reservation-Orders-Issued.

READ—the following papers:—

- 1. Government of India, Ministry of Home affairs, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Memo No.39016/6/77-Estt(C), dated 4-11-1977.
- 2. G.O. Ms.No.73, Social Welfare, dated 1-2-1980.

ORDER:

The Government of India in their office Memorandum first read above, have reserved 1 percent vacancies each for the blind, the deaf and the Orthopaedically handicapped with an overall ceiling of 3 percent in Group 'C' and 'D' posts in Central Services and in comparable posts in Central Public Sector Undertakings and they have requested State Governments to give urgent consideration for reservation of 3 percent vacancies for the Physically Handicapped in State Services and State Public Sector Undertakings.

- 2. This Government have reserved 18 percent and 50 percent of seats/vacancies in all Educational Institutions and in Public Services—for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes respectively. As the Government of Tamil Nadu are wedded with the policy of rehabilitating the physically handicapped persons and are forerunners in implementing welfare schemes for the physically handicapped as the year 1981 has been declared as "International Year of the Disabled Persons" the Government after careful consideration pass the following orders. 3 percent of the vacancies/seats shall be reserved in all State Public Services/Educational Institutions, under all kinds of management. (like Government, local bodies and aided managements) including Universities where the rule of reservation is applicable for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.
- 3. The reservation of 3 percent for physically handicapped persons ordered above shall be made as noted below: --
- (a) Out of the quota of 18 percent reserved for Scheduled Castes'Scheduled Tribes, 3 out of every 100 vacancies/seats—shall be reserved for physically handicapped persons belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes.
- (b) Out of the quota of 50 percent reserved for Backward Classes. 3 out of every 100 vacancies seats shall be reserved for physically handicapped persons belonging to Backward Classes.
- (c) Out of the quota of 32 percent intended for Open Competition 3 out of every 100 vacancies seats shall be reserved for Physically Handicapped persons in general.

- 4. The reservation of seats in educational institutions as per the above orders shall be condition for the payment of any grant-in-aid from the funds of the Government to the Educational institutions run by any local body/Management or University.
- 5. Necessary amendment to Rule 22 of the General Rules will be issued separately by the Government in Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department.
