Social Welfare—Welfare of Physically handicapped-Reservation of 3 per cent of vacancies to physically handicapped persons-Maintenance to rosters-Orders-Issued.

Order-No. 1207, Social Welfare, dated 21st July 1987.

- In G.O. Ms. No. 602, Social Welfare Department, dated 14th August 1981, orders have been issued for the reservation of 3 per cent vacancies/scats in State Public Services/Educational Institutions, etc., for the Physically handicapped persons. In G.O. Ms. No.983, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 7th October 1986, orders have been issued amending General Rule 22 of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules.
- 2. Consequent on the orders issued in Government Order third read above, amending Rule 22 of the General Rules (Part II of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules in Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1977), the Government direct that the 3 per cent reservation of vacancies for the physically handicapped persons should be strictly followed as per the rotation indicated in the Government Order third read above.
- 3. The Government also direct that all Heads of Departments/Institutions should render annual returns to the Director of Social Welfare in the proforma I and II annexed to this order on or before 28th February of every year.
- 4. The Government also direct that all the Heads of Departments/institutions should issue instructions to their inspecting Officers at State and District levels, to inspect and to report whether 3 per cent reservation for the handicapped is adhered to in all the offices under their control. The Government further direct that all Heads of Departments/Institutions should produce records for verification relating to appointment, etc., in all offices during inspecting to ensure strict adherence of 3 per cent reservation for the handicapped. All Heads of departments/Institutions are requested to issue suitable instructions to the subordinate offices under their control for the production of records relating to appointment, etc., to the Inspecting Officers during inspection.
- 5. All Heads of Departments/Institutions are informed that the 3 per cent reservation for physically handicapped should invariably be incorporated in the notifications inviting applications for various posts advertised by them.


