ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued to delegate powers to the Principal Secretary / State Commissioner for the Differently Abled to on incur expenditure and to implement the following 4 Welfare Schemes of Differently Abled Persons with the condition that the expenditure should be incurred only within the Budget provision of the respective Head of Account:-

- i. Maintenance Allowance to Mentally Retarded persons;
- ii. Maintenance Allowance to Severely Affected persons;
- iii. Maintenance Allowance to Persons affected with Muscular Dystrophy; and
- iv. Maintenance Allowance to Leprosy affected persons.

Further, the Government have permitted the Principal Secretary / State Commissioner for the Differently Abled to send necessary proposal to Government for sanction of funds if required for the additional beneficiaries identified subsequently in the month of September and February.

2. In the Government Order second read above Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.58,47,000/- to provide maintenance allowance to 630 additional beneficiaries for 4 months from December 2014 to March 2015 and 689 additional beneficiaries identified during February 2015 for 2 months from February 2015 and

March 2015, totalling 1319 Additional beneficiaries identified during the month of September 2014 and February 2015.

- 3. In the letter third read above, the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.64,44,000/- for providing maintenance allowance to 1074 additional beneficiaries in the category of Severely Affected Persons in waiting list of September 2015.
- 4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of State Commissioner for the Differently Abled and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.64,44,000/-(Rupees Sixty four lakhs and forty four thousand only) to provide maintenance allowance to 1074 additional beneficiaries identified in the category of Severely affected persons during September 2015 at the rate of Rs.1500/- per month for 4 months from December 2015 to March 2016
- 5. This expenditure at para 4 above shall be debited under the following Head of Account:-

"2235- Social Security and Welfare-02. Social Welfare-101- Welfare of Differently Abled Persons- I- Non Plan- CD- Maintenance Allowance to the Severely affected Differently Abled Persons-09- Grants-in-aid 03 Grants for Specific Schemes. (DPC:2235 02 101 CD 0938)

- 6. Necessary funds are provided in Final Supplementary Estimates 2015-2016.
- 7. This order issues with concurrence of the Finance department vide its U.O. No. 12400/Fin(SW)/2016, dated 03.03.2016.
