## ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Government have permitted for the establishment of Early Intervention Centre for children with Autism at Tirunelveli and to be managed by DIYA TRUST OF INDIA for the year 2013-14 and sanctioned a sum of Rs.47,000/- for implementation of the scheme.

2. In the Government Order second read above, Government have permitted to run the Early Intervention Centre for children with Autism at DIYA TRUST OF INDIA, Tirunelveli District for the year 2014-15 and sanctioned a sum of Rs.2,82,000/-.

3. In the letter third read above, the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled has requested the Government for the continuance of the Early Intervention Centre for children with Autism at Tirunelveli with an estimated cost of Rs.2,82,000/- for the year 2015-16.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled and issue the following orders:-

- i. The State Commissioner for the Differently Abled is permitted to continue to run the Early Intervention Centre for children with Autism at DIYA TRUST OF INDIA, Tirunelveli District for the year 2015-16.
- ii. Financial Sanction is accorded for incurring an expenditure of Rs.2,82,000/-(Rupees Two lakhs and eighty two thousand only) as detailed below :-

- iii. To permit the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled to draw and disburse the amount as an advance to the present implementing Non Governmental Organisation namely, DIYA TRUST OF INDIA, Tirunelveli.
- iv. To permit the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled to decide on the selection and removal of implementing the Non Governmental Organisation with the concurrence of Government.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 (ii) above, shall be debited under the following head of account:-

2235-Social Security and Welfare-02 Social Welfare-101-Welfare of Differently Abled Persons-Schemes in the twelfth five year plan-II State Plan- MX-Assistance to NGOs for Special Institutions for children with Autism-09-Grants-in-Aid 03- Grants for Specific Schemes. (DPC 2235-02-101-MX-0938)

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2,82,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2015-16. Pending Provisions of such funds in RE/FMA 2015-16, the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled is authoised to draw and incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 4(ii) above. The State Commissioner for the Differently Abled is also requested to include this expenditure of Rs.2,82,000/- in the RE/FMA for 2015-16, while sending a proposal to Finance (SW) Department without fail.
