The major objectives of the institute are to impart professional training, conduct research render clinical services and educate the public on issues related to communication disorders such as hearing impairment, speech & languages disorders associated with mental retardation, cerebral palsy, cleft lip and palate, learning disability etc.

Situated in a lush green campus of 32 acres adjacent to the University of Mysore in Manasagangothri, Mysore, it is a unique institute in the Asian sub-continent with its eleven departments and a well equipped Library and Information Centre. These departments have state-of-the-art facilities to offer inter-disciplinary training to the students.

AIISH caters to clients of all ages having a whole range of communication disorders. The institute attracts students from all over India and abroad. Further, in the allied disciplines like Clinical Psychology, Linguistics, Electronics & Acoustics, eight faculty members in AIISH have obtained Ph.D and some more pursuing the same.



#### NATIONAL SEMINAR ON BASIC AUDIOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT

The All India Institute of Speech and Hearing (AIISH) was established in the year 1965 as an autonomous institute fully funded by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The major objectives of the institute are imparting professional training, conducting research in the areas of speech, language and hearing, rendering clinical services and educating the public on issues related to the communication disorders.

The comprehensive audiological evaluation involves use of different test protocols for the diagnosis and rehabilitation of various hearing disorders. The knowledge of selecting the appropriate protocol and handling of audiological equipments is very much essential for the accurate hearing assessment. Hence, the professionals and the students who are dealing with the individuals with hearing disorders require adequate training in selecting appropriate protocols and efficient handling of various audiological instruments for better diagnosis and rehabilitation.

In this regard, the Department of Audiology of the institute is organizing three days workshop on "National seminar on Basic Audiological Assessment" from 08<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> October 2014. The objectives of the workshop is to update and enrich the knowledge of the speech and hearing professionals and students on basics of audiological evaluation, usefulness of different audiological tests in differential diagnosis and better handling of audiological equipments. It is open to the undergraduate and post graduate students, professionals in the field of speech and hearing.
