- b) Number of words of the essay ranges from 500 to 1000 words,
- c) Participant can write the essay in local language but they have to send along with the same its English translation, as the competition is on international level.
- Personal information of the participant should be sent in the attached format along with the essay before 31st May, 2018 at Email ID: administration@nabindia.info
- 5] Cash Prizes:
 - a) First prize is \$1000
 - b) Second prize is \$500 for one winner of the group below age 25 and one winner of the group above age 25
 - c) Third prize is \$200 for two winners below age 25 and two winners above age 25.

The Essays so received will be evaluated by a local selection committee and five best essays so selected will be sent to the international selection committee of Asian Blind Union for further selection of the Essays for the prizes.

You are earnestly requested to spread this information amongst individual Visually Impaired Persons /Special Schools for the Blind & Other Institutions working for the Education/Welfare of Visually Impaired Persons from your area so as to get the maximum participation in the competition.
